SWP promotes the well-being of employees, corporate productivity and the social, environmental and economic sustainability of businesses.

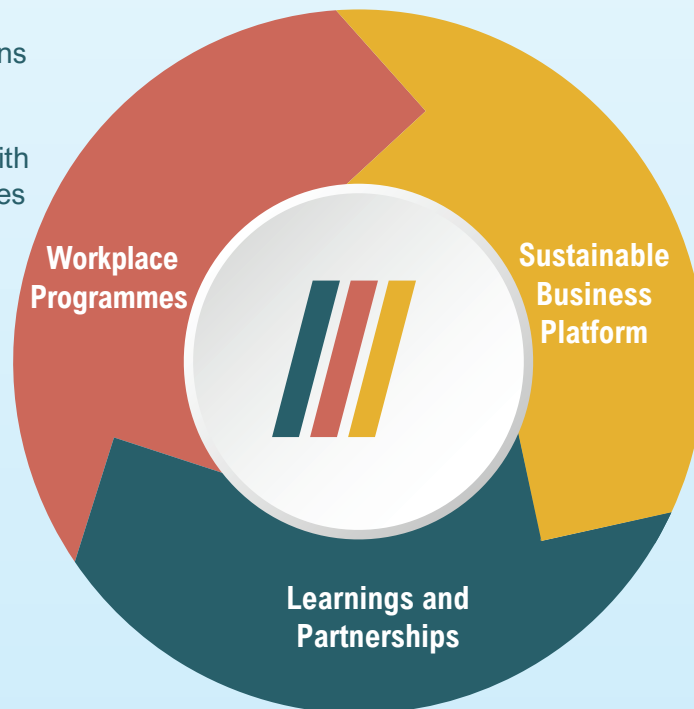
## Who we are

## How we work

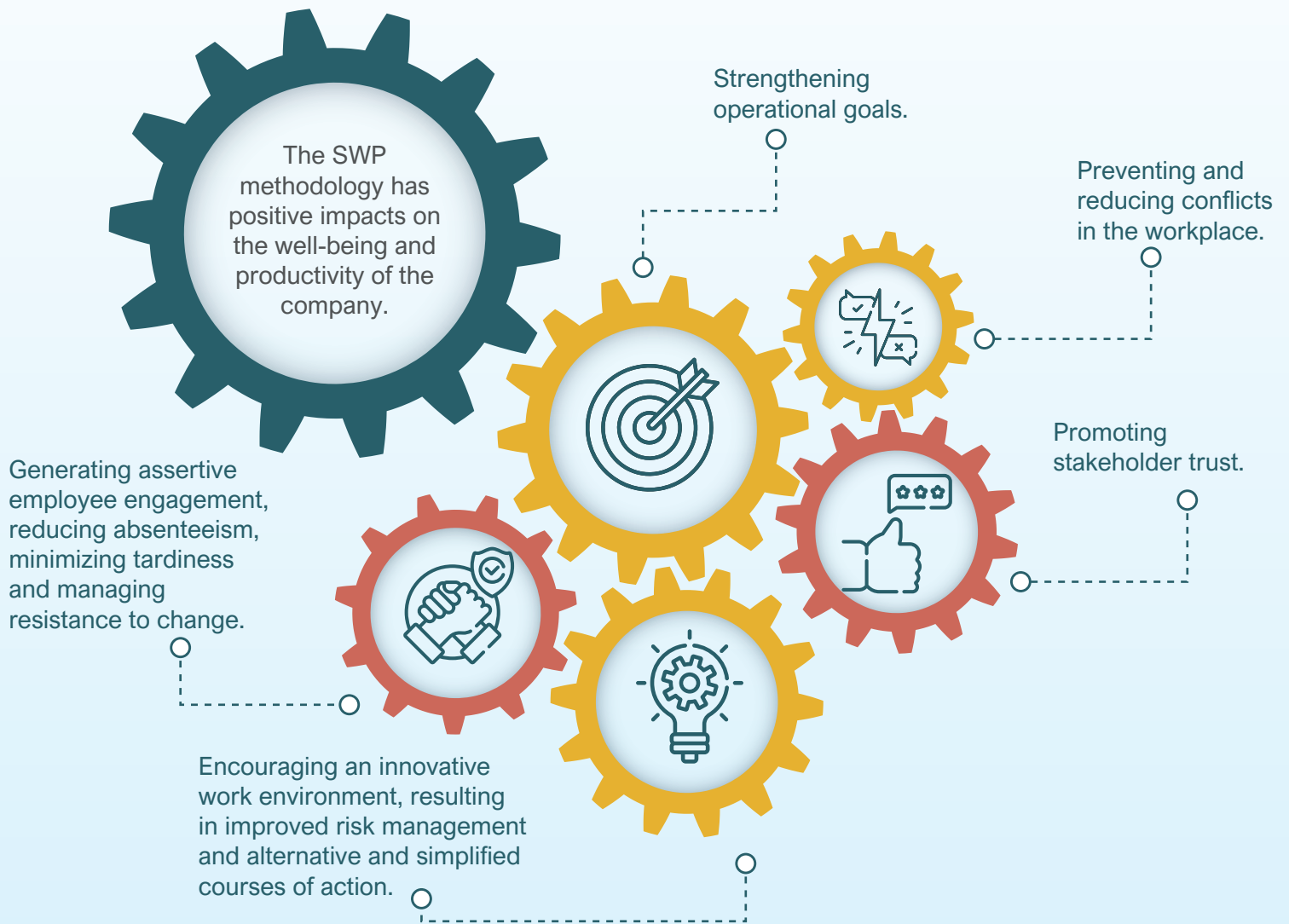
